## Christian Roots in America

Is it important that we recover our understanding of ourselves as a Christian nation?

Solomon tells us “Except Jehovah build the house, They labor in vain that build it. Except Jehovah keep the city, The watchman waketh but in vain...” Psalm 127:1—He was speaking of nations when he issued this admonition. Today, God is purposely excluded from our nation’s decision making process and most of her public activities.

God told Jeremiah “At what instant I shall speak concerning a nation, and concerning a kingdom to pluck up and to break down, and to destroy it: if that nation concerning which I have spoken, turn from the evil; I will repent of the evil that I thought to do to them.” Jeremiah 18 :8-7

Again God says “Righteousness exalts a nation; But sin is a reproach to any people.” Proverbs 14:34

God tells us “...if my people who are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways: then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sins, and will heal their land.” 2nd Chronicles 7:14
